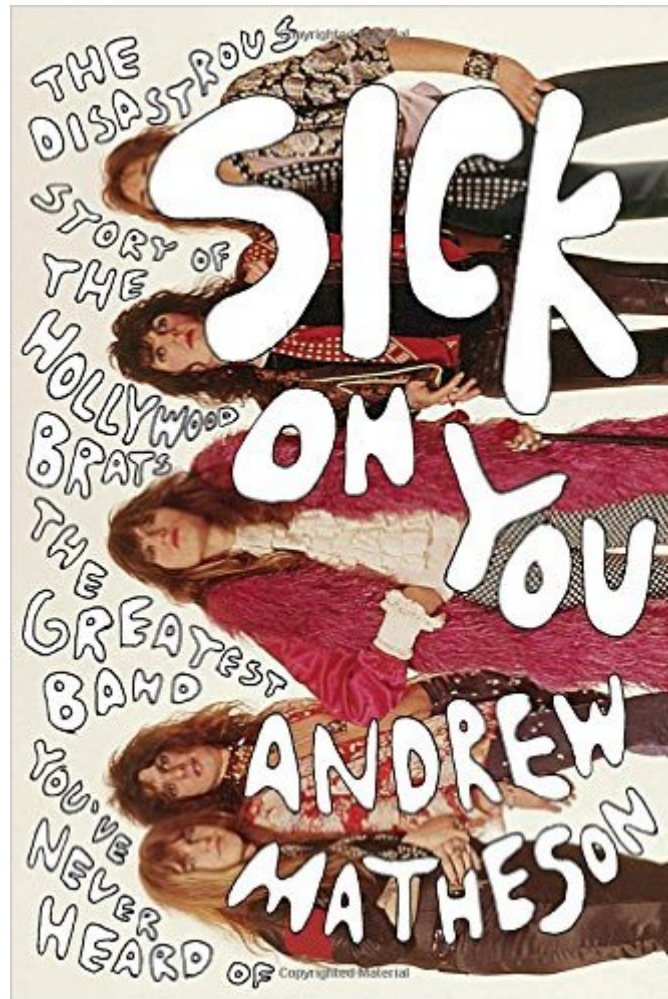


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Sick On You: The Disastrous Story Of The Hollywood Brats, The Greatest Band You've Never Heard Of
